

Create a drawing

Open Google Drive. Click on New> More> Google Drawings.

Add lines

There are 6 types of lines you can add to your drawing: line, arrow, elbow connector, curved connector, curve, Polyline, Scribble.


- 1- At the top of the page, click on Insert.
- 2- Click on Line and select the type of line you want.




Add shapes

There are four different shape categories you can choose from: general shapes, callouts, equation, and arrows.

- 1- At the top of the page, click on
- 2- Click on Shapes and pick the one you want.
- 3- Click and drag on the canvas to draw your shape.





Insert Charts



Using the Chart button you can insert Bar, Column, Line, Pie or insert charts from Google Sheets:


- 1- At the top of the page, click on Insert. 2- Click on Chart and select what
- you want to add.




Insert Text

You can place text anywhere in your canvas. You can also resize text box and choose different text styles: 1- At the top of the page, click

- 4- Click to resize and format it.






