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1) Video conferencing



Zoom

Zoom supports the following features: up to 100 participants, 49 videos on screen, private and group chat, video breakout rooms, screen sharing and many more.

2) Collaborative whiteboarding



Jamboard

Work together on jams in real-time: import pictures, add text, draw with a stylus or handwrite, import content from Docs/Sheets/Slides, and many more.

3) Collaborative writing



Supports the following collaborative features: co-editing documents in real-time, sharing instantaneous feedback, suggesting edits, sharing and collaborating with over 100 people.

4) Digital citizenship

According to Jerry Fingal (ISTE) The five competencies of digital citizenship are:

Inclusive:

Be respectful, empathetic, and open to different viewpoints.

Informed:

Use digital media in a critically conscientious way.

Engaged

Leverage the power of digital technology for civic engagement and for the social good of all.

Balanced

Learn how to create a healthy balance between your onscreen and off-screen time.
